

Reminder of Your Confidential Participant ID

Your *Confidential Participant ID* will be the last four characters of your mobile phone's serial number. Please do not give your Confidential Participant ID to anyone, this is for you *and only you* to know.

iPhone Users:

Step 1: Go to Settings > General and tap About.

Step 2: Look for the serial number.

Note: You might need to scroll down to find the IMEI/MEID, and ICCID.

Samsung Users:

Step 1: Go to system settings.

Step 2: Scroll down and tap on about Phone option.

Step 3: Serial number should be displayed.

Example:

Mobile phone serial number is DQ9J7SN2P6

Your Confidential Participant ID is N2P6
